



2021 Central Coast Pinot Noir

2021 David Bruce Central Coast Pinot Noir is a selection from cool climate vineyards located in Santa Lucia Highlands and Santa Barbara County.

Santa Lucia Highlands brings out the cherry, cranberry, and fruit-forward character, while Santa Barbara fruit brings out the spice, mineral, and well-structured tannin profile. This is a food-friendly and bright pinot noir with loads of spice and perfume.

Nose:

Cranberries, raspberry, crushed peppercorns, dried flowers with earthy and mineral tones.

Palate:

Dark cherries, boysenberry, blackberries, dark plums, red peppers, star anise. Rich tannins with food-matching acidity.
